

## History of the Goto College of Medical Arts and Sciences

- 1953 Tokyo-Eisei-Gakuen School with the two faculties  
Practical Nursing and Massage Therapy established  
First School Principal: Shin'ichi Goto
- 1956 Odawara-Eisei-Gakuen School with the faculty  
Massage-Shiatsu Therapy established
- 1962 Faculty Acupuncture, Moxibustion and Massage Therapy  
in the Odawara School opened
- 1967 Faculties for Higher Nursing and Acupuncture, Moxibustion  
and Massage Therapy in the Tokyo School opened
- 1972 Yugawara-Eisei-Gakuen School established
- 1973 Tokyo School and Odawara School incorporated as Goto College
- 1977 The Tokyo and Odawara School become Special Training Schools
- 1979 Faculty of Rehabilitation in the Tokyo School opened
- 1983 Academic Exchange and Cooperation with the Beijing School of  
Chinese Medicine (today: Beijing University of Chinese Medicine) started
- 1986 Construction of a new building for the Tokyo School finished
- 1987 Academic Exchange and Cooperation with the Tianjin School of  
Traditional Chinese Medicine (today: Tianjin University of Traditional  
Chinese Medicine) as well as with the California State University Long  
Beach started
- 1988 Odawara School and Yugawara School merged into  
Kanagawa-Eisei-Gakuen School
- 1990 Affiliation with the American College of Traditional Chinese Medicine
- 1992 Faculties Oriental Medicine Clinical Education and  
Rehabilitation 2 (evening classes) in the Tokyo School opened
- 1993 Tokyo School Clinical Center for Acupuncture and Moxibustion  
(today: Clinical Training Center for Acupuncture and Moxibustion)  
opened

(today: Massage Treatment Center) opened
- 2003 Academic Exchange and Cooperation with the Acupuncture & Integrative Medicine College, Berkeley started  
Yokohama International Swimming Pool Acupuncture, Moxibustion and Massage Therapy Center (as part of the Kanagawa School) opened  
Goto College 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary
- 2005 Renewal and Enhancement of the Cooperation with the German VPT Akademie and the Dresden International University
- 2006 Cooperation with the Foeldischule GmbH  
A Nursing Corresponding Course and the Faculty of Oriental Medicine in the Tokyo School opened
- 2007 Agreement of a inter-university transfer system with the Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine and the Beijing University of Chinese Medicine  
The Tokyo School Lymphedema Institute opened
- 2010 Clinical Center for Chinese Medicine opened
- 2012 Relocation of the Massage Treatment Center and Lymphedema Institute to Shinjuku
